

Internet Connectivity Solutions and Resources Guide for Migrant Housing



Solution 1: Wired connection: Fiber, Cable, DSL or Fixed Wireless **Resource:** Migrant Housing Internet Connectivity Reimbursement Program will provide up to \$1000.00 per migrant housing unit for setting up internet connectivity including: MIFI hotspots, routers, antennas/boosters, set-up, and service fees. Proof of payment required for reimbursement.



Solution 2: Cellular connection for small group **Resource:** MIFI Hotspot Lending Program will provide through a local partner a MIFI hotspot with unlimited data. Available to migrant housing without access to alternative wired connection and with less than 20 workers in one location.



Solution 3: Cellular connection for large group **Resource:** Internet Hub Pilot Project will provide a powerful cellular network router, antenna, installation and an unlimited data plan for the season. Available to migrant housing without access to alternative wired connections and with more than 20 workers in one location.
